

FOREIGNER'S CHECKLIST FOR PROPERTY ACQUISITION IN RWANDA

Visa/Permit for Rwanda

You need to make sure that you have a valid permit/Visa to live/stay in Rwanda

Find property and Ownership info

With UPI(Property Identification number), Check if property is labelled for what you want(Agriculture or residential)

Agreement of Sale Signed at the Notary

Make an Agreement of Sale' contract" upon which the seller expects at least a half deposit.

Make Land Title Transfer

After paying a 100%, you need to go to Sector office(Land department) or at Authorized Private Notary for Land Title transfer so the property will be under your names.

The Buyer& The seller have to sign paperworks at the Notary

Check Title transfer Info

After 1 month of transfer, You can start checking if it is transferred to you by Dialing *651# on your Rwandan mobile Phone







WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



A foreigner may own one plot of land for one family in a residential area that does not exceed 300 square meter. (Size limit may differ based on Locations and master plan)



A foreigner can own land above 300 Sqm for investment/business (rental properties, company production, agriculture and farming)



To own a land for business or investment, you need to have an investment certificate from RDB.

(Please note, if you are creating a business with no intent to purchase land...you do not have to complete the above steps)
